We entered 2024 with a promise to 'Invest in Our People' as our Prospectus detailed, with a keen focus on the health and wellbeing of everyone at GAC and delivering new training and development opportunities across the Group.

Early in the year we rolled out the Effective Communication in GAC (ECG) course, which aimed to evolve the Academy's existing communications courses to include topics on the appropriate use of Artificial Intelligence (AI), email and messaging app etiquette, effective verbal and non-verbal communication, listening skills and more.

We were also able to run several iterations of the new Personal and Professional Development (PPD) courses in 2024, enabling personnel across GAC to deepen their self-knowledge and build strong goals and effective action plans to help achieve those goals in the coming years.

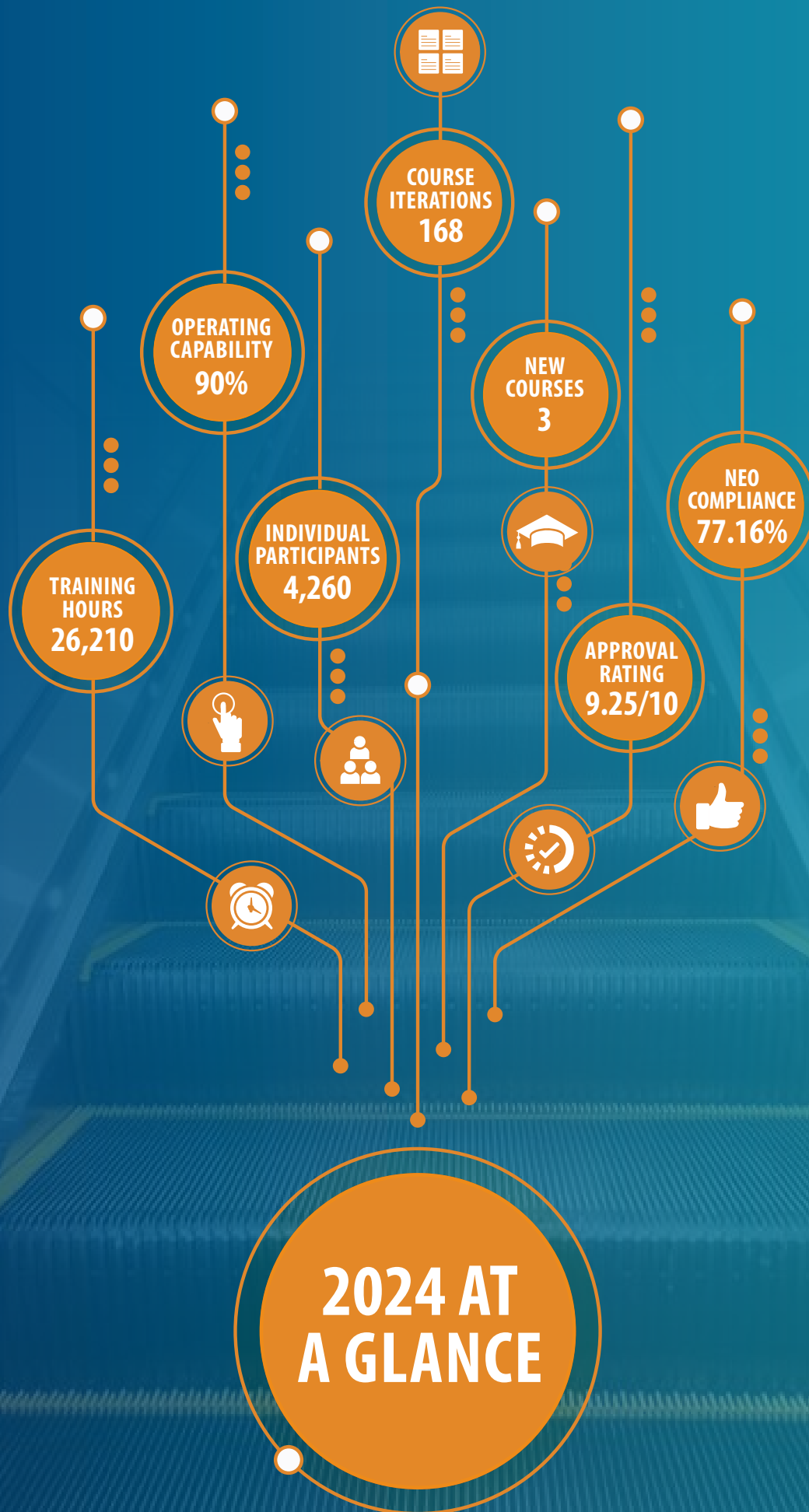
Our focus on the health and wellbeing of GAC's people is reflected in the ongoing wellbeing courses offered at the Academy, with a substantial number of people completing the Mental Health Champion (MHC) and Mental Health First Aid Certification (MHF) courses in 2024.

The milestone for GCA was the New Employee Orientation (NEO) for Skilled Workers or NSW course, designed for people in the field. NSW is available in five languages and demonstrates GCA's determination to bring training opportunities to all GAC people no matter their station or native language! To further this aim, the Academy's own GACreach app was developed and launched, enabling course completion from mobile phones and devices with the app installed, greatly increasing the reach and accessibility of GCA courses.

To round off the year successfully, we were also pleased to have had our ISO 21001:2018 Educational Organisations – Management Systems for Educational Organisations (EOMS) certification renewed for another year, reflecting the Academy's commitment to quality alignment with the GAC Group as a quality-centred organisation.
